

#### **Prosperous**

An innovative, productive and low carbon society which recognises the limits of the global environment and therefore uses resources efficiently and proportionately (including acting on climate change); and which develops a skilled and well-educated population in an economy which generates wealth and provides employment opportunities, allowing people to take advantage of the wealth generated through securing decent work.

#### Resilient

A nation which maintains and enhances a biodiverse natural environment with healthy functioning ecosystems that support social, economic and ecological resilience and the capacity to adapt to change (for example climate change).

#### Healthier

A society in which people's physical and mental well-being is maximised and in which choices and behaviours that benefit future health are understood.



#### **More Equal**

### Vibrant Culture and Thriving Welsh Language


A society that promotes and protects culture, heritage and the Welsh language, and which encourages people to participate in the arts, and sports and recreation.

# Principle



#### Long-term

The importance of balancing short-term needs with the needs to safeguard the ability to also meet long-term needs



#### Prevention

How acting to prevent problems occurring or getting worse may help public bodies meet their objectives



#### Collaboration

Acting in collaboration with any other person (or different parts of the body itself) that could help the body to meet its well-being objectives



#### Integration

Considering how the public body's well-being objectives may impact upon each of the well-being goals, on their objectives, or on the objectives of other public bodies



#### Involvement

The importance of involving people with an interest in achieving the well-being goals, and ensuring that those people reflect the diversity of the area which the body serves

### **Long Term**

Balancing short term and long term and exploring alternative futures




Figure 4. Bringing the futures back to the present. Foresight approaches differ from forecasting and other attempts to predict the future using linear trends. Foresight explores possible futures ( ), to help you prepare for alternatives, and to understand your preferred future or vision.
