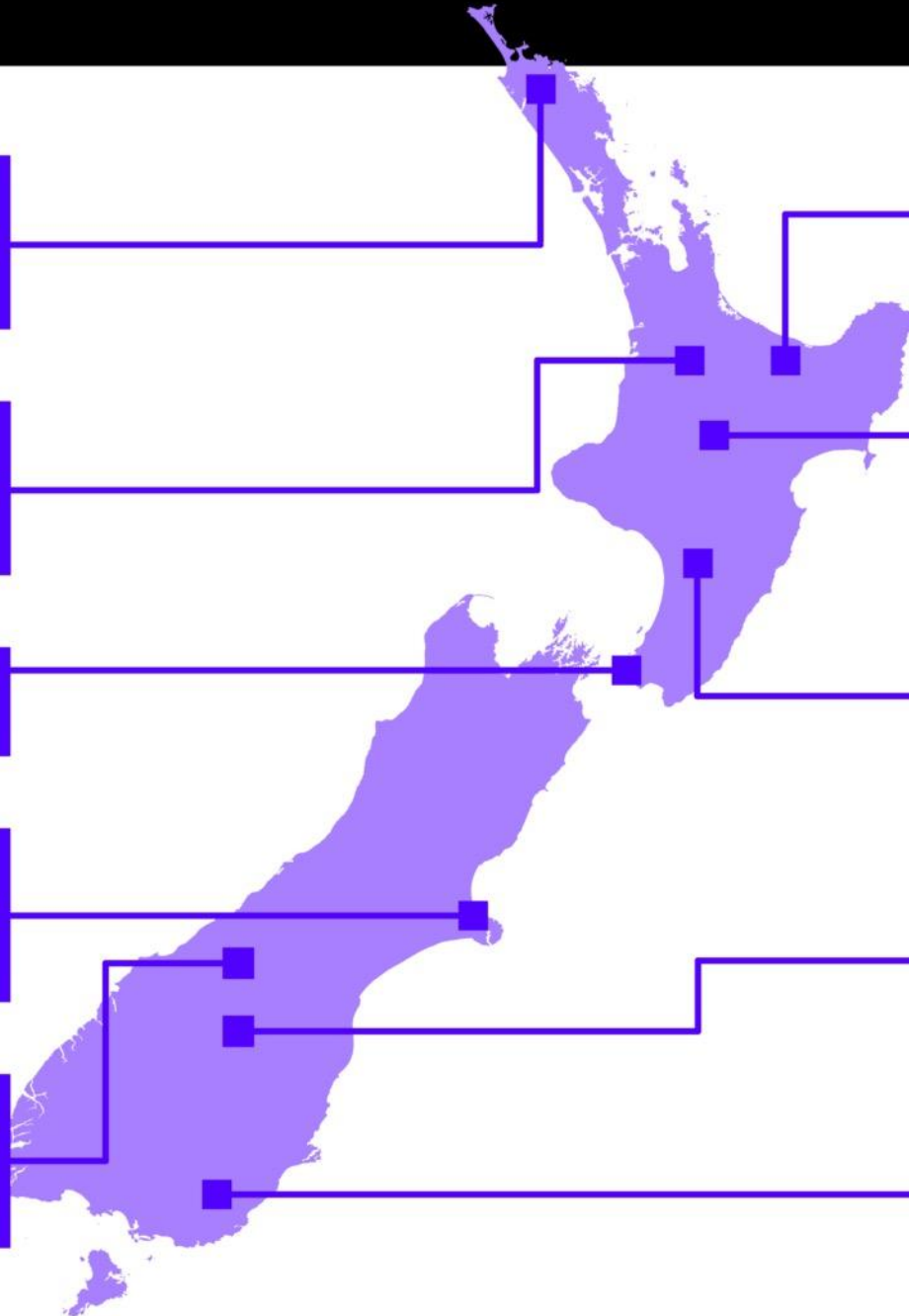

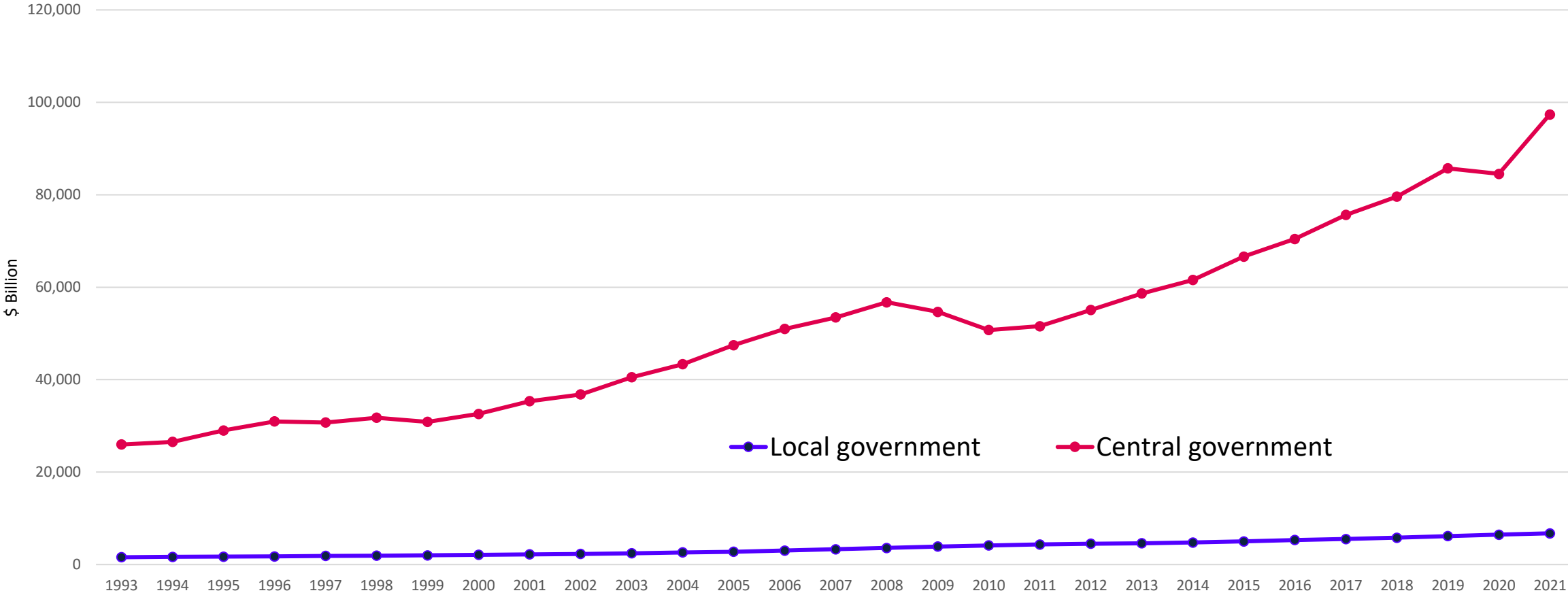

“This is not so much a new idea, but rather a return to a way of governance that was practiced in New Zealand for hundreds of years before Europeans arrived. Concepts like tino rangatiratanga (independence) and mana motuhake (self-determination) reinforce the importance of place within Māori society.”

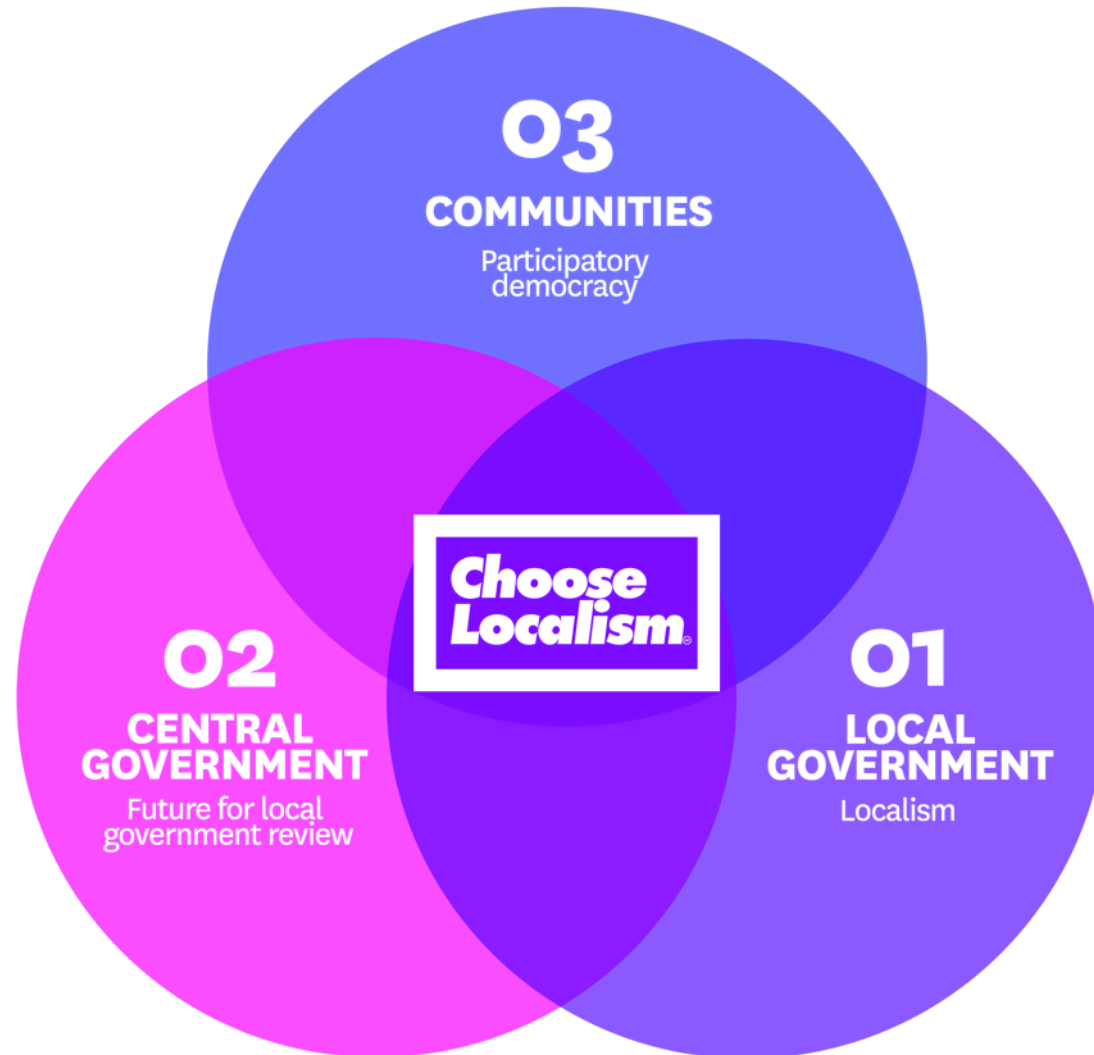
